EPA and MassDEP Dewatering and Remediation General Permit Workshop Fall 2023

Classroom Course Details

<u>1. Overview:</u> Discussion of the general applicability of the dewatering and remediation permits; examples of real sites where the permit is required. Instructors will demonstrate how to access the permit documents. (15 minutes)

2. MassDEP Application Process: When and how to contact MassDEP regarding DRGP coverage, including in-depth discussion of dilution factors and State water quality-based limits; how to complete MassDEP application forms and when fees are required, including when anti-degradation review applies. The instructors will demonstrate MassDEP specific forms and tools. (30 minutes)

<u>3. EPA Application Forms and Requirements:</u> How to apply for permit coverage and meet the electronic Notice of Intent requirements using new electronic formats, including in-depth discussion of sampling requirements, discharge limits, and endangered species criteria. Guided by the instructors, attendees will fill out electronic forms on their own (or shared) laptop; use of EPA's Central Data Exchange and the electronic Notice of Intent will be highlighted, and common errors will be identified. (60 minutes)

<u>4. Monitoring and Reporting Requirements:</u> How to meet the monitoring requirements of the new DRGP; what steps to take to meet the corrective action requirements in the event of a limit exceedance. How to fulfill reporting requirements using e-reporting tools. The instructors will demonstrate EPA specific forms and instructions, including EPA's NetDMR. (30 minutes)

5. Questions/Answers: Q&A will happen throughout the course but there will be time at the end of the course for more questions (15 minutes)
