PRIMARY FUNCTIONS

The Senior Geotechnical Engineer is responsible for the following primary functions:

- Design and optimize earth support systems for excavation and retaining wall projects, considering factors such as soil properties, groundwater conditions, and project specifications.

- Proficiency in geotechnical software applications such as GeoStudio, Plaxis, FLAC, and Slope/W.
