

**MassDEP is hiring: Environmental Analyst III – Remedial Project Manager (RPM)**

**MassDEP Bureau of Waste Site Cleanup is seeking two candidates to serve as a Remedial Project Manager (RPM) in its Federal Sites section in Boston, MA.**



The successful candidates will serve as RPM and/or assistant RPM for State oversight of complex site assessment and remediation projects at federal Superfund sites and/or Department of Defense sites. The RPM will work to ensure that the site assessment and response actions meet the stated objectives and the requirements of federal and state laws and regulations. The RPM may also manage long-term remedy operation, maintenance, and monitoring programs at State-managed Superfund Sites.

Responsibilities will include reviewing and providing comments on technical plans, analytical data, reports and legal documents related to the investigation and assessment of the nature and extent of contamination, human health and ecological risk, and the development, evaluation, and implementation of remedial measures at federal sites; representing MassDEP at meetings with project teams and stakeholders; and working collaboratively with internal and external project stakeholders to accomplish project objectives. The RPM will work under the supervision of more experienced staff and will help to ensure that the state’s interests in assessment and cleanup of federal sites are represented.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS**

- Experience in the assessment of complex disposal sites and the evaluation and selection of remedies for such sites.
- Experience in performance or oversight of waste site cleanup activities such as site investigation and characterization, data evaluation, human health and ecological risk assessment, remedial alternative development and evaluation, remedy implementation, or long-term monitoring.
- Knowledge and application of the principles and practices of environmental science disciplines as they relate to contaminated site assessment and remediation
- Familiarity with State or Federal Waste site cleanup laws, regulations, and guidance.
- Experience with contractor management/oversight processes, including developing budgets and scopes of work; monitoring of work quality, schedule, and budget status; and completing required reporting.
