- Prepare scopes of work, cost estimates, project schedules, and environmental documentation
- Provide technical guidance and ensure regulatory compliance related to oil and hazardous material releases

- Participate in the Clean Harbors LSP Emergency Response Team, including on-call rotations (typically one week every other month, depending on staffing), to oversee spill response, documentation, and environmental sampling

Field Inspector

The Field Inspector will support MCP-related projects both in the field and office. Key responsibilities include:

- Conducting site observations and field sketches
- Documenting activities with detailed logs and reports
- Identifying potential site issues and consulting with senior staff when necessary
- Conducting soil classification (soil classification knowledge a plus)
- Preparing technical reports, letters, and data tables
- Bachelor's degree in Environmental Science, Engineering, Geology, or a related field preferred

Ideal candidates should be organized, detail-oriented, safety-conscious, and eager to learn. Occasionally extended workdays and outdoor work in various weather conditions may be required.

Project Scientist

The Project Scientist will play a key role in assessing Conceptual Site Models and communicating with clients, property owners, and officials. In addition to many Field Inspector responsibilities, additional responsibilities include:

- Managing Immediate Response Actions, Release Abatement Measures, and Phase I & II investigations under the guidance of the LSP
- Collaborating with LSPs to advance project goals
- Evaluating project data and ensuring proper documentation
- Working knowledge of the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP; 310 CMR 40.0000), required
- Familiarity with environmental regulations and best practices
- Experience in environmental site assessments, investigations, and/or technical reporting

Successful candidates will be confident in their communication skills and capable of working independently under limited LSP supervision.

Licensed Site Professional (LSP)

The LSP will manage project phases under the MCP and work with environmental guidance policies, with responsibilities such as:

- Overseeing site assessments, sampling, and remediation techniques
- Managing junior staff and mentoring team members
- Maintaining client relationships and seeking new business opportunities

Candidates must have a strong knowledge of the MCP and associated guidance, with the ability to adapt to regulatory changes.
