Jeremiah Duncan, Ph.D., Senior Chemist, GZA GeoEnvironmental

Jeremiah Duncan is a Senior Chemist in the Environmental Remediation and Environmental Site Investigation Groups at GZA and has more than 25 years of experience in analytical and environmental chemistry. Dr. Duncan brings chemical expertise and data analysis skills to provide support to project teams and clients on PFAS-impacted sites ranging from fire training and large industrial facilities to small businesses and landowners. Currently, he is co-authoring a white paper on PFAS forensics with a task group of the National Groundwater Association.

Dr. Duncan holds a B.S. in Chemistry from the Missouri University of Science and Technology, as well as an M.A. and a Ph.D. in Chemistry from Princeton University.
